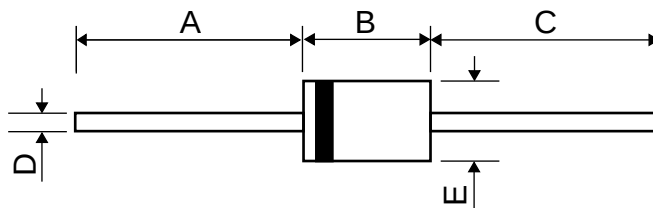

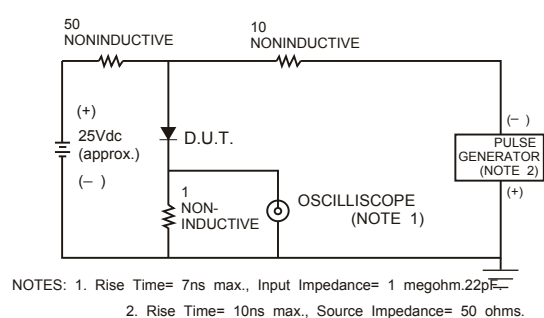
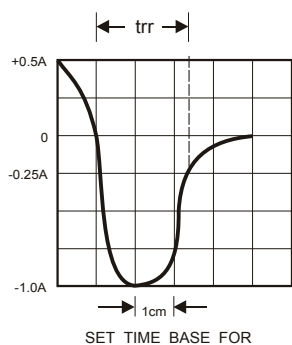


FIG.1 TEST CIRCUIT DIAGRAM AND REVERSE RECOVERY



TIME CHARACTERISTIC

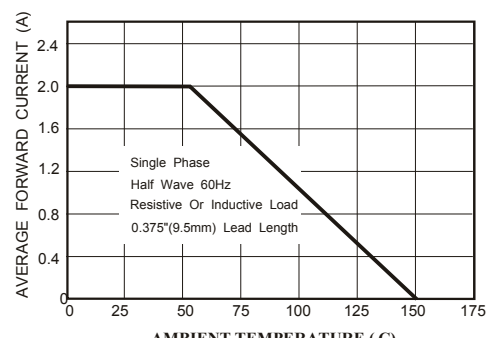


FIG.2-TYPICAL FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE

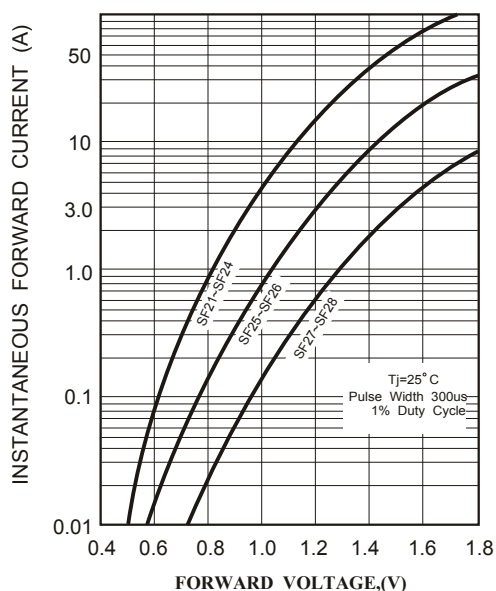


FIG.3 TYPICAL FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS

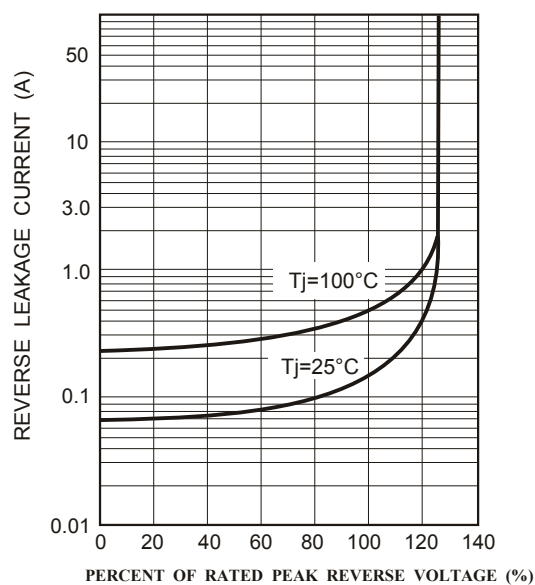


FIG.4 TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS

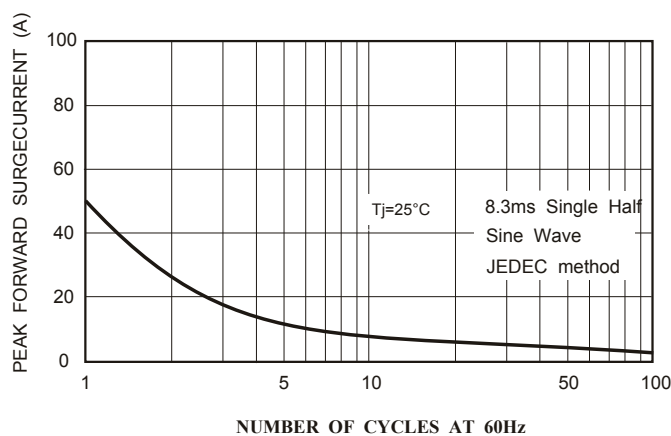


FIG.5 MAXIMUM NON-REPETITIVE FORWARD SURGE CURRENT

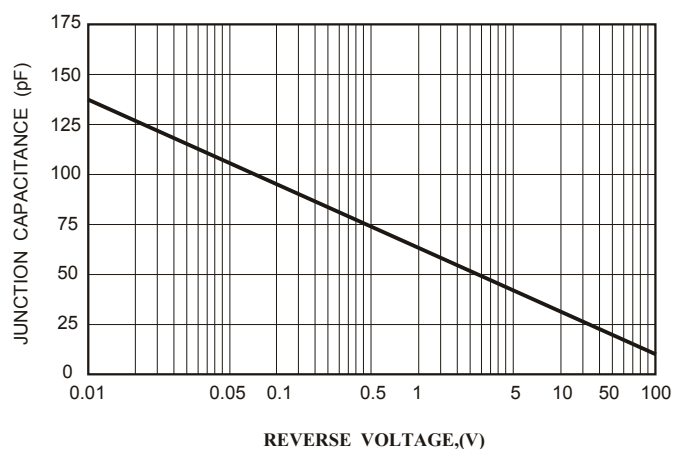


FIG.6 TYPICAL JUNCTION CAPACITANCE
