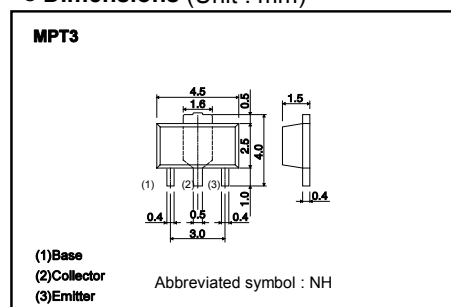

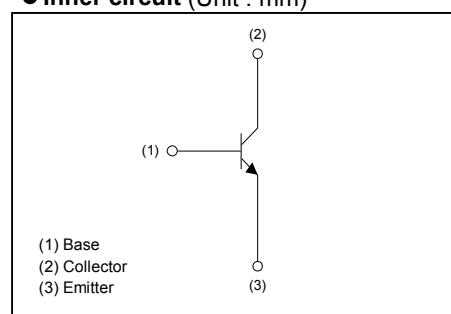

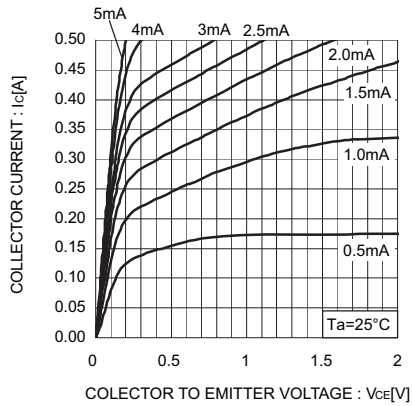


Fig.1 Typical Output Characteristics

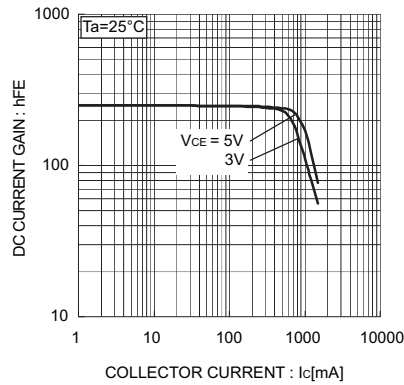


Fig.2 DC Current Gain vs. Collector Current (I)

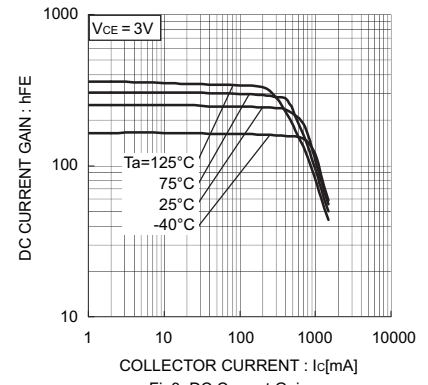


Fig.3 DC Current Gain vs. Collector Current (II)

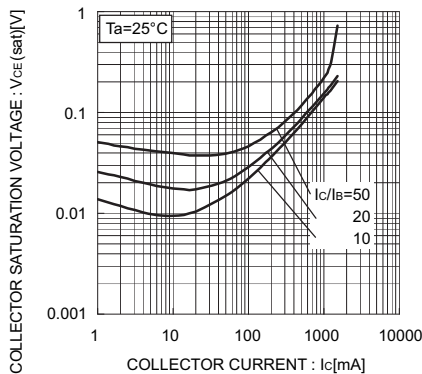


Fig.4 Collector-Emitter Saturation Voltage vs. Collector Current (I)

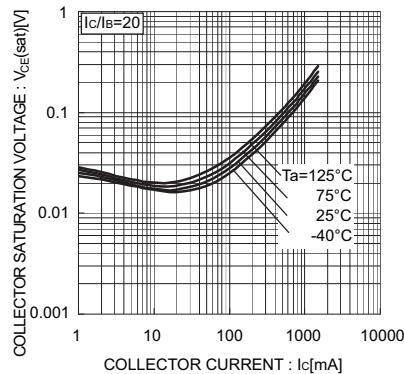


Fig.5 Collector-Emitter Saturation Voltage vs. Collector Current (II)

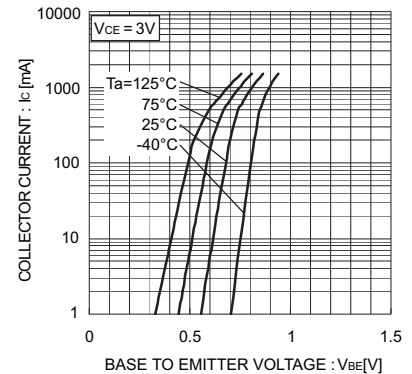


Fig.6 Ground Emitter Propagation Characteristics

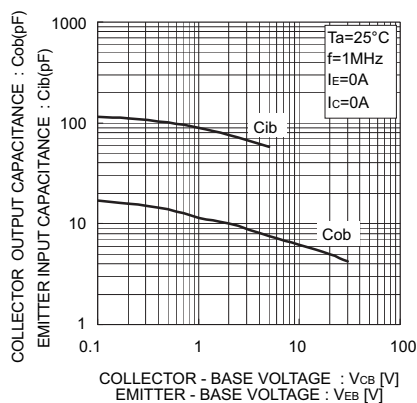
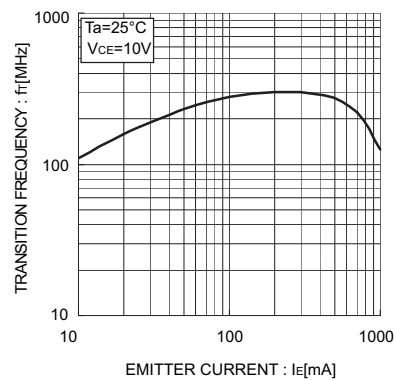
Fig.7 Emitter Input Capacitance vs. Emitter-Base Voltage

Fig.8 Gain Bandwidth Product vs. Emitter Current

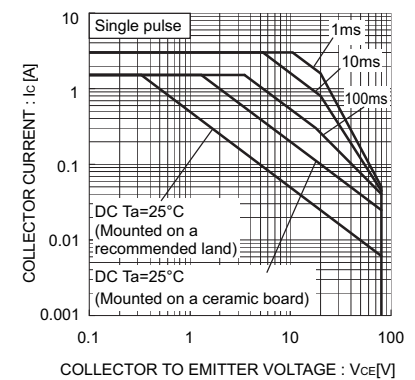
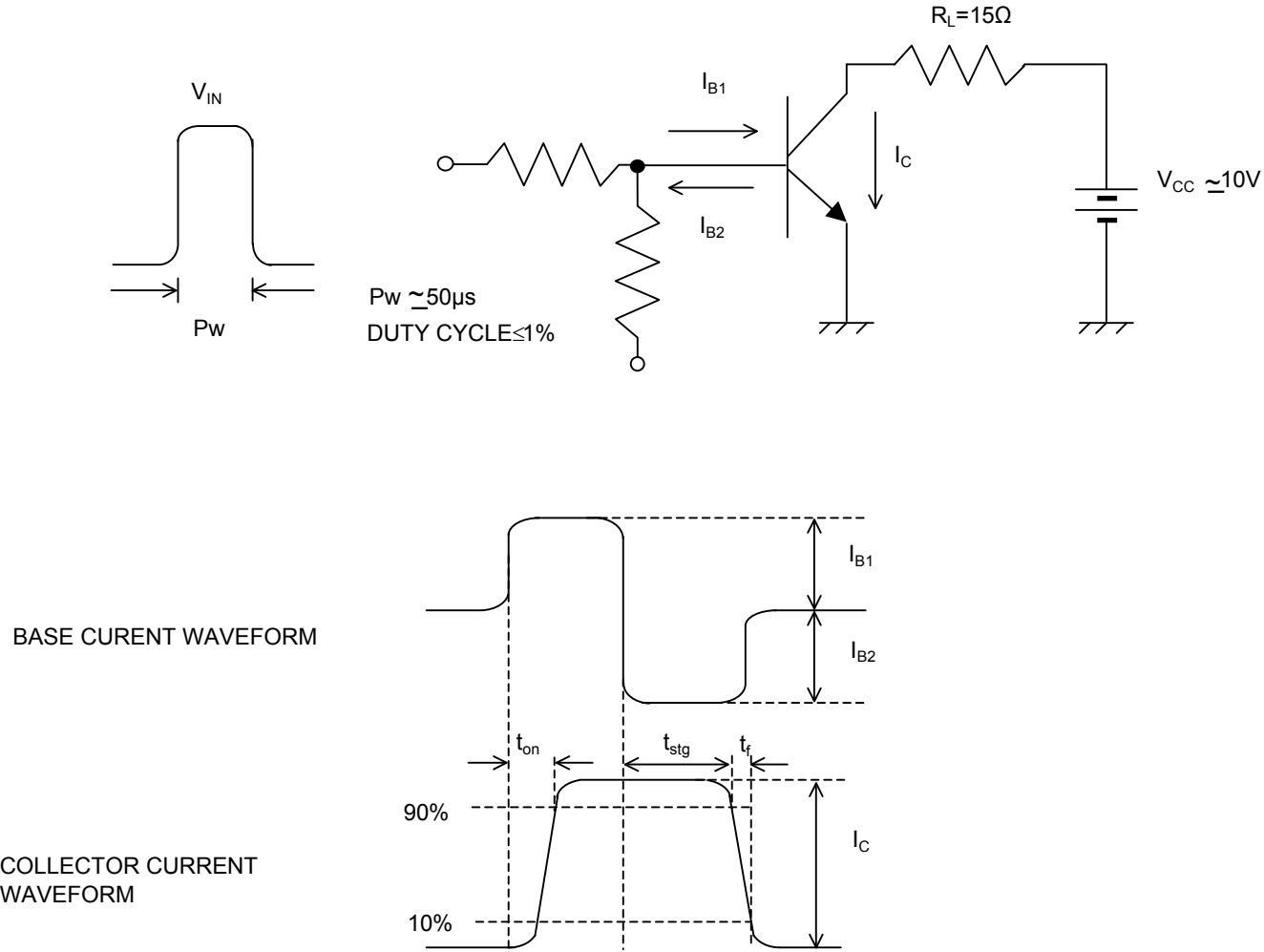


Fig.9 Safe Operating Area
