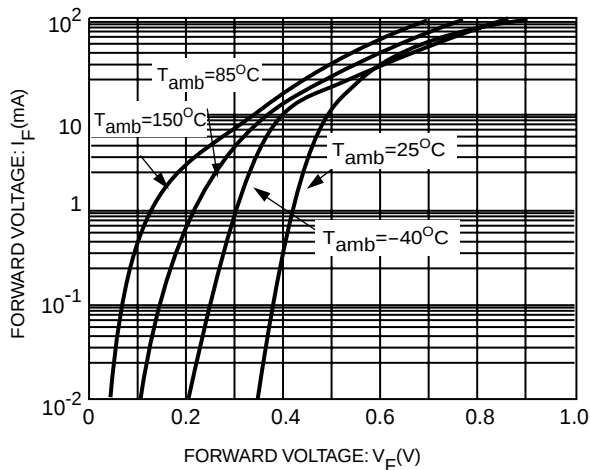


Fig.1 Forward current as a function of forward voltage; typical values.

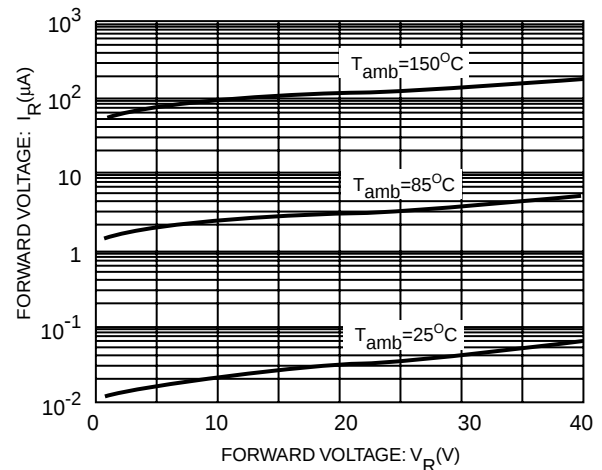


Fig.2 Reverse current as a function of reverse voltage; typical values.

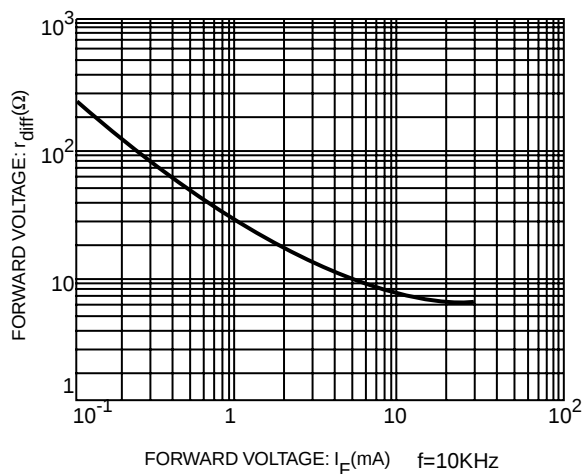


Fig.3 Differential forward resistance as a function of forward current; typical values.

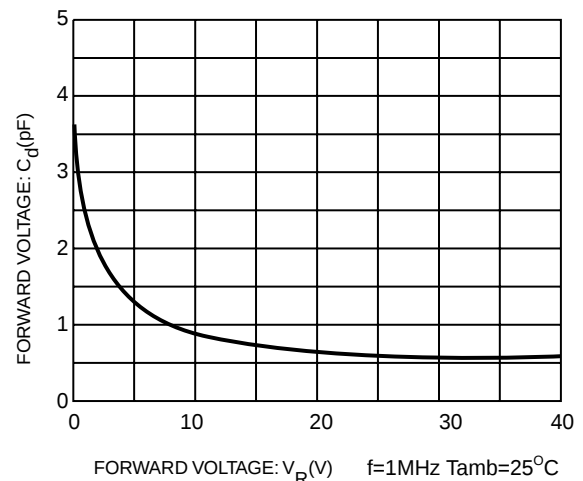


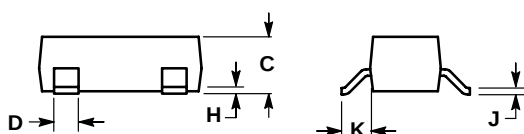
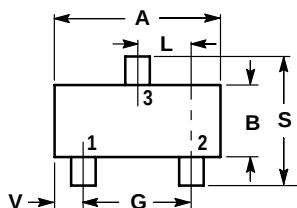
Fig.4 Diode capacitance as a function of reverse voltage; typical values.
