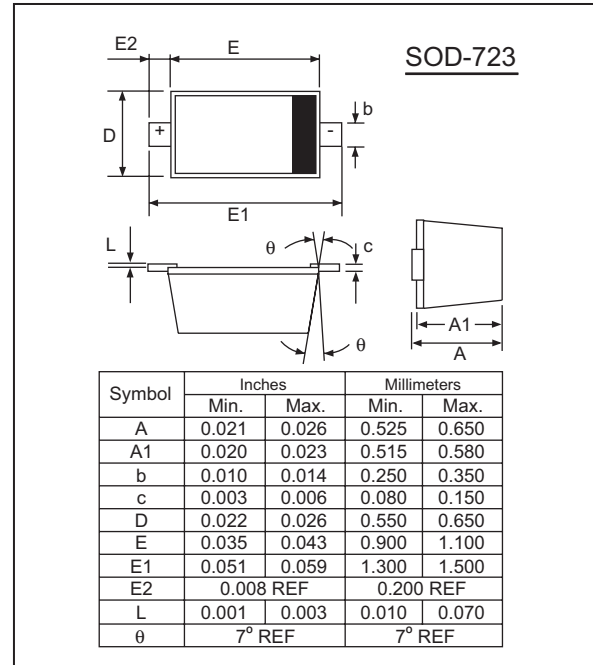

Fig. 1 Forward Characteristics

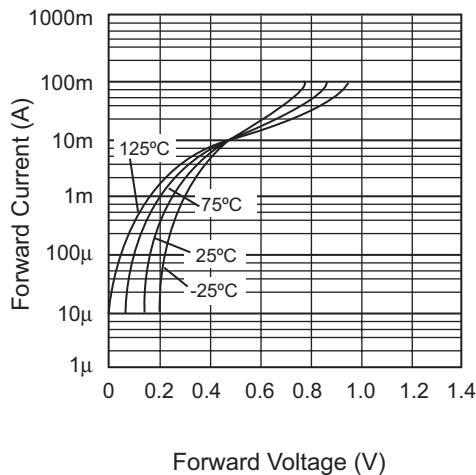


Fig. 2 Reverse Characteristics

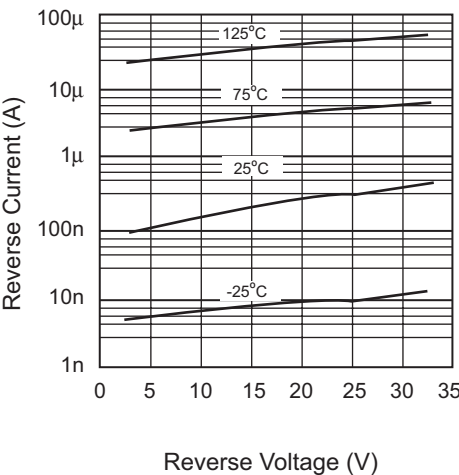


Fig. 3 Capacitance between Terminals
