



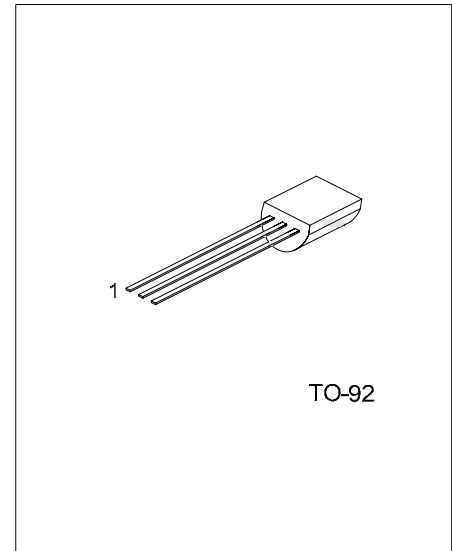

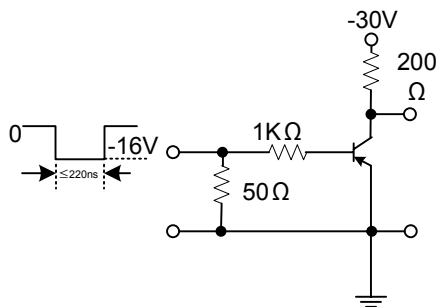


Figure 1. Saturated Turn-On Switching Timer

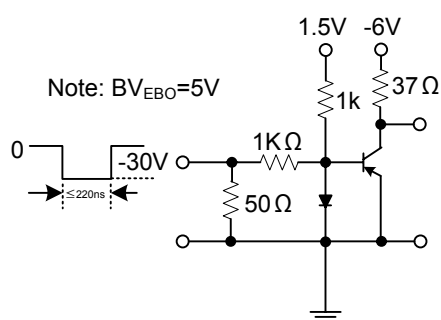
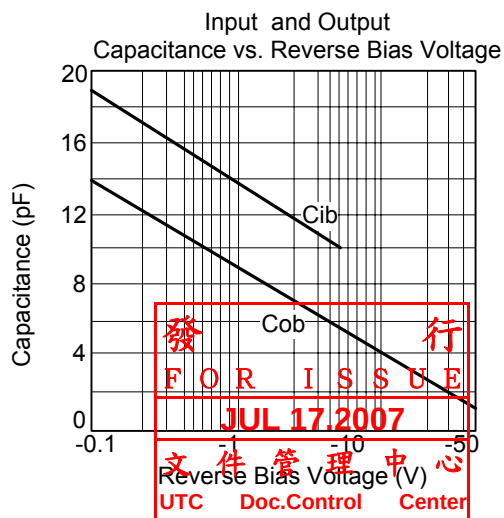
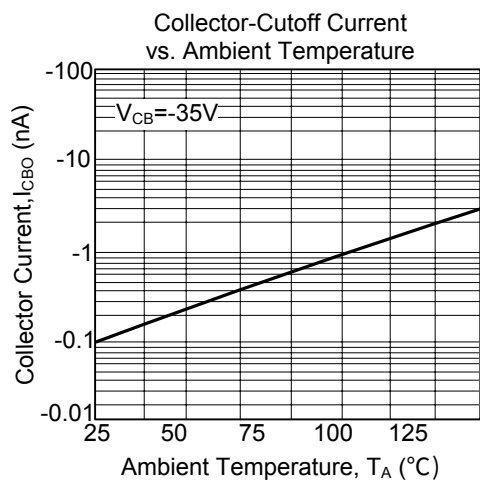
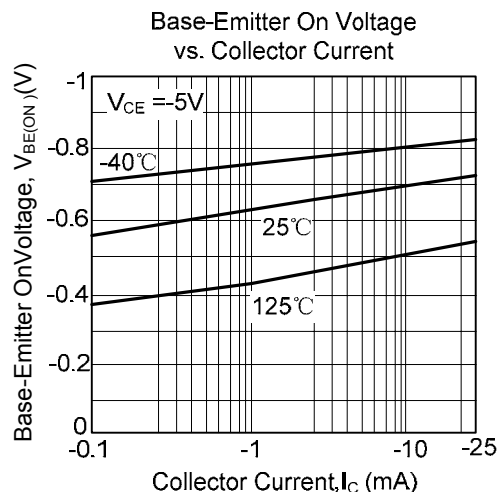
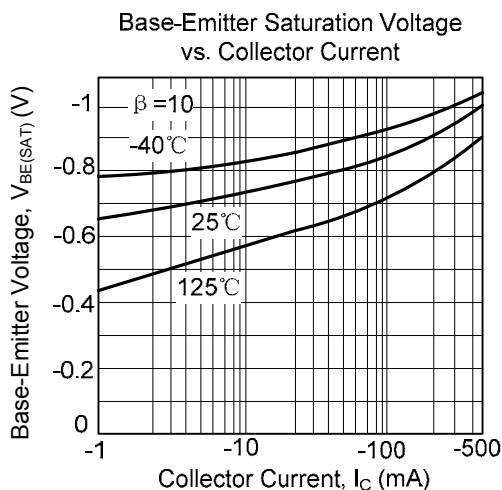
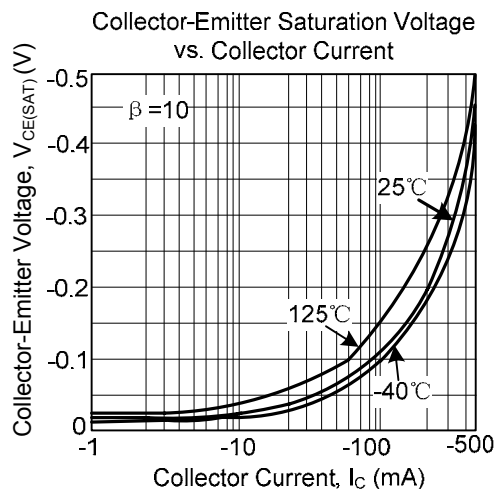
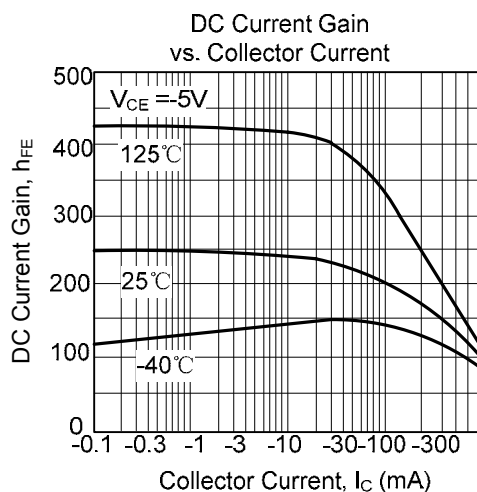


Figure 2. Saturated Turn-Off Switching Timer
