General Description

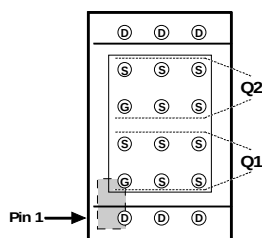
Combining Fairchild's advanced 2.5V specified PowerTrench process with state of the art BGA packaging, the FDZ2551N minimizes both PCB space and $R_{DS(ON)}$. This dual BGA MOSFET embodies a breakthrough in packaging technology which enables the device to combine excellent thermal transfer characteristics, high current handling capability, ultra-low profile packaging, low gate charge, and low $R_{DS(ON)}$.

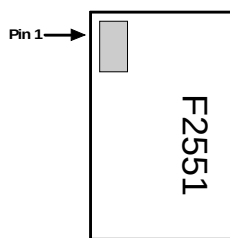

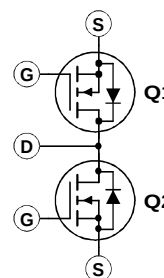

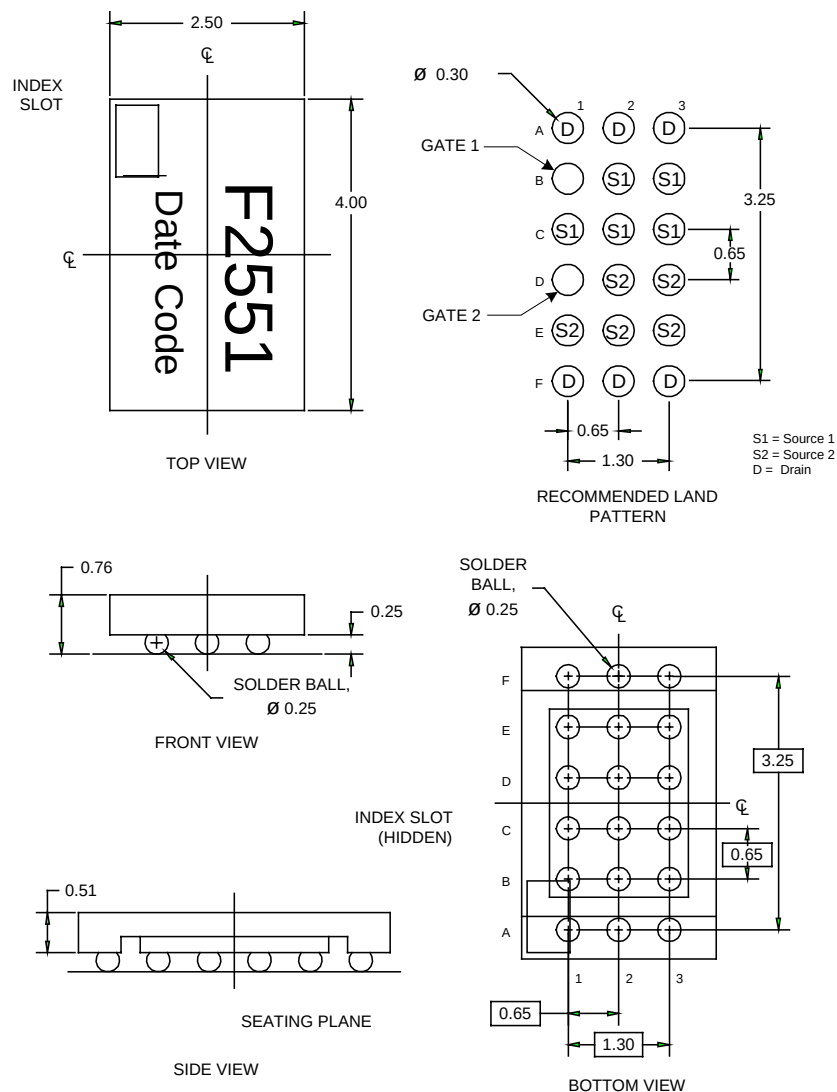
Notes:

- $R_{\theta JA}$ is a function of the junction-to-case ($R_{\theta JC}$), case-to-ambient ($R_{\theta CA}$) and the PC Board ($R_{\theta BA}$) thermal resistance. For the purpose of determining $R_{\theta JC}$ the case thermal reference is defined as the top surface of the package. $R_{\theta JC}$ is guaranteed by design while $R_{\theta CA}$ and $R_{\theta BA}$ are determined by the user's design. Maximum current ratings assume single device operation.

(a). $R_{\theta JA} = 50^\circ\text{C/W}$ (steady-state) when mounted on 1 in² of 2 oz. copper.
