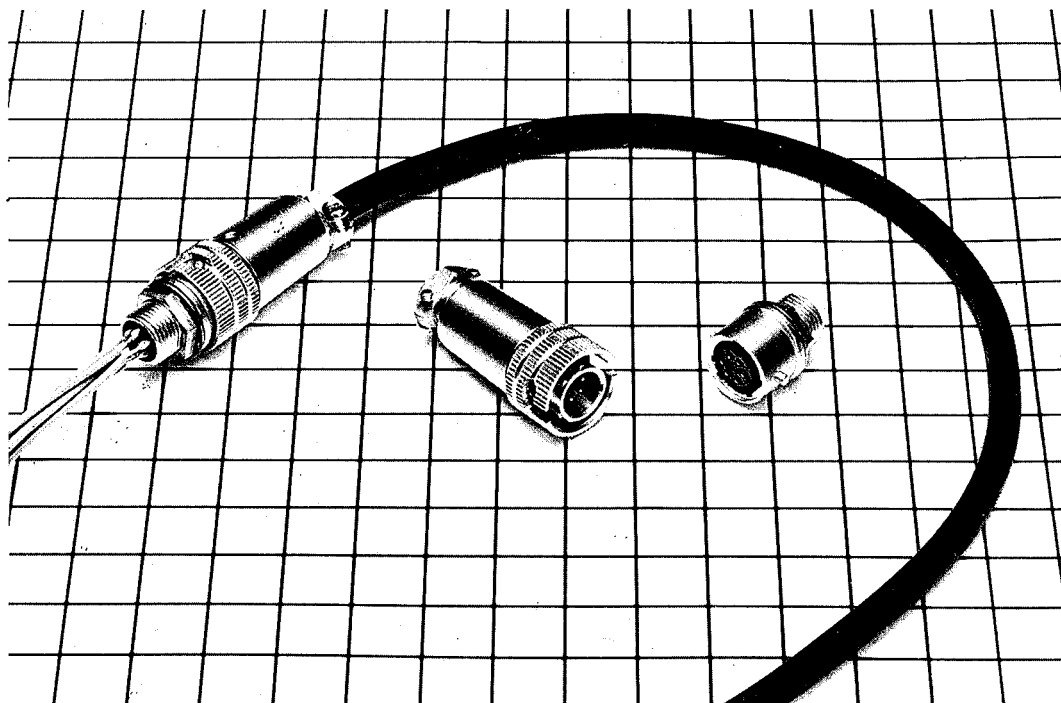


HR11 SERIES SHELL SIZE 9mm BAYONET LOCK CONNECTORS

Scope

HR11 Series circular connectors have been developed for applications with compact sized electronic equipment. Small size and reliability are key features of the HR11.

The applications include communications devices, instrumentation, broadcasting studios, and other electronic equipment.



Features

1. A five-key mating guide helps to guide the connector into the specified position even without looking.
2. Contacts are located at safe positions to prevent the contact pins from being damaged when trying to fit the mating guide (fine keys) blindly.
3. Connector is easy to insert and extract due to the bayonet locking mechanism.
4. Enhanced packaging density using hexagon headed nut tightening system to fix the receptacle to the panel.
5. Each model of the connectors is available in male and female, to suit all requirements.
6. Slim and streamlined design with satin finish surface matches compact devices without spoiling the appearance.

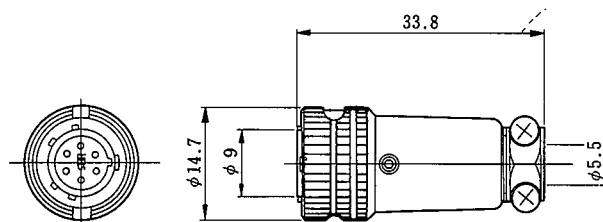

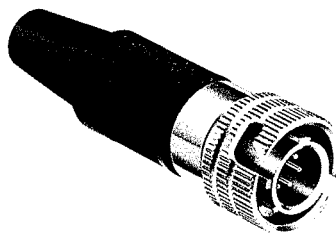

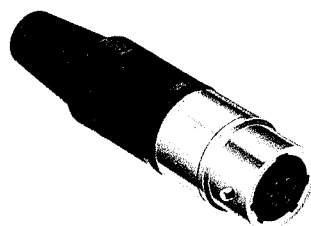

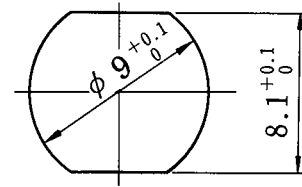

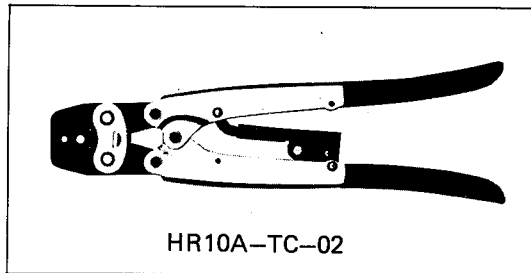
