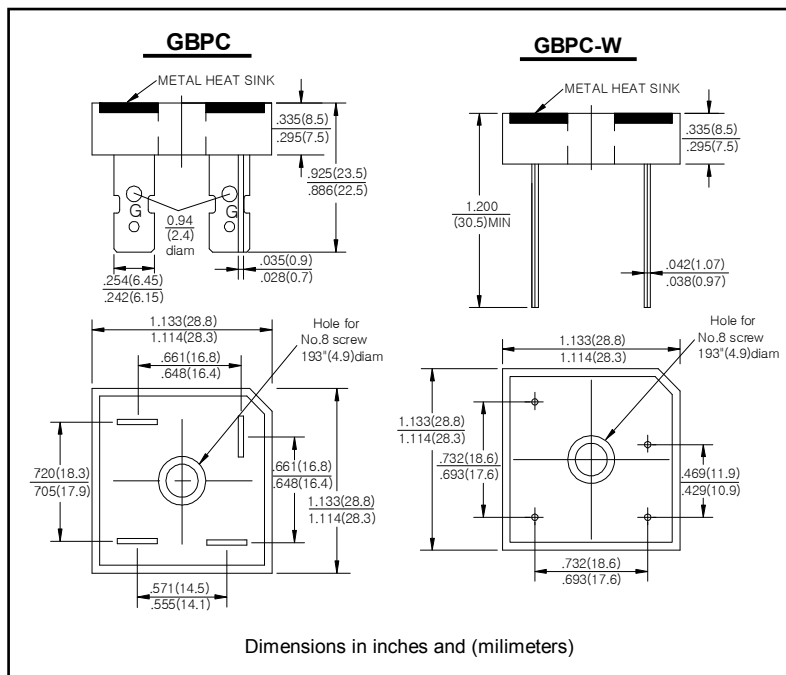

FIG.1-MAXMUN FORWARD SURGE CURRENT

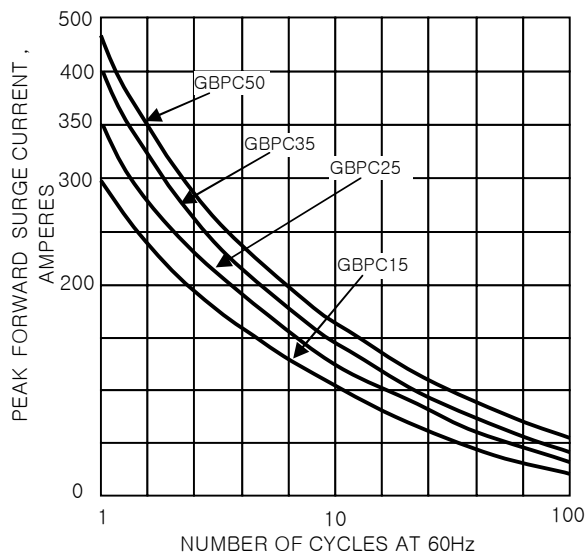


FIG.2-DEATING CURVE OUTPUT RECTIFIED CURRENT

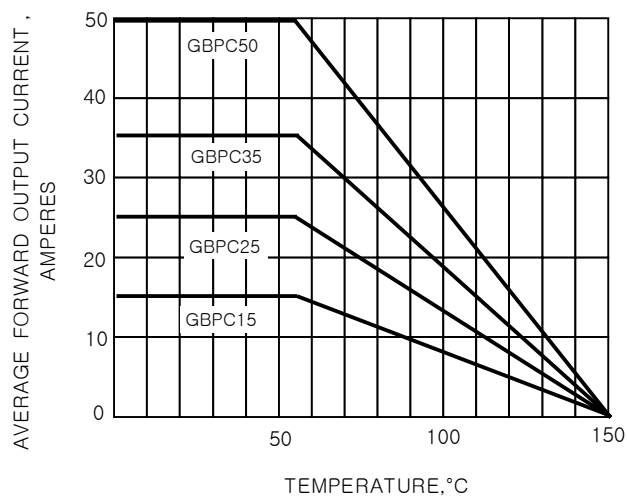


FIG.3-TYPICAL FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS

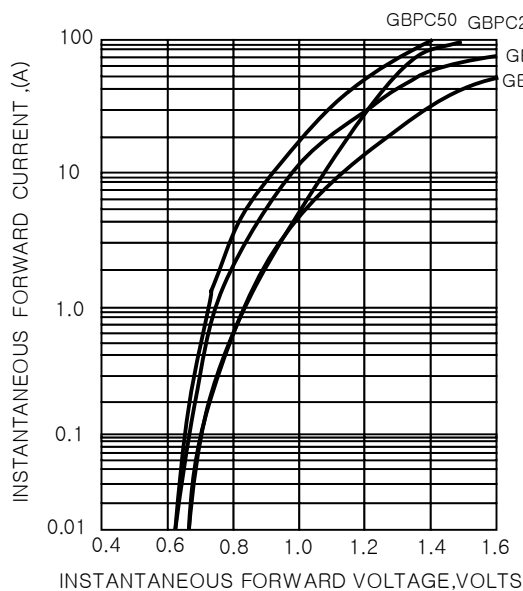


FIG.4-TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS
