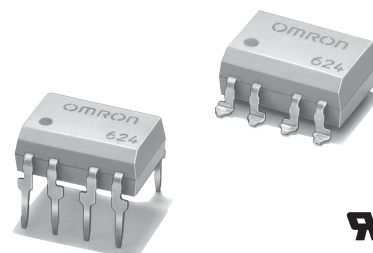

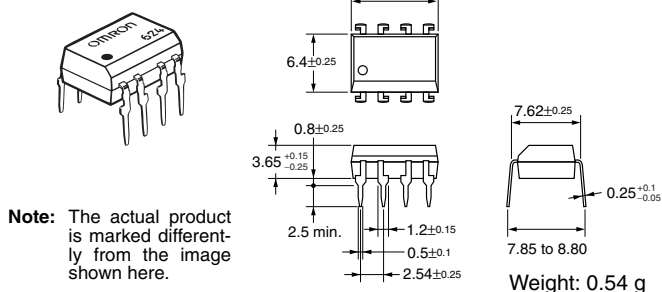

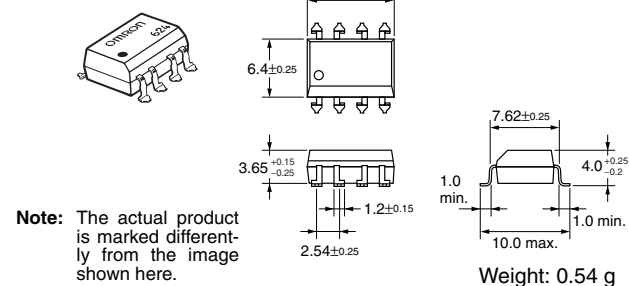

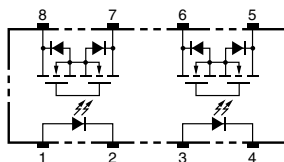

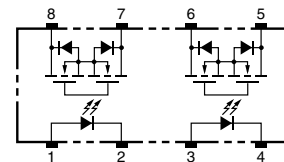


Terminal Arrangement/Internal Connections (Top View)

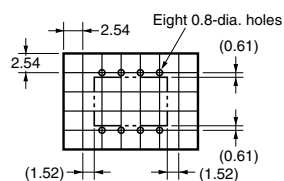

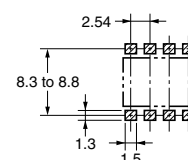
PCB Dimensions (Bottom View)

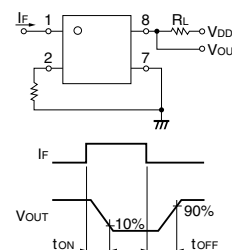

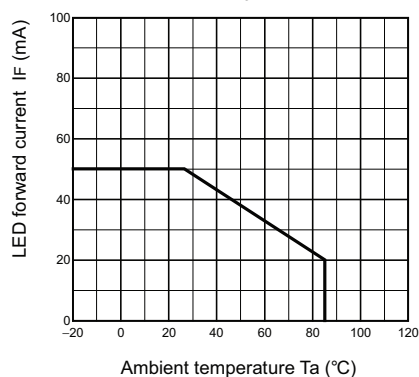

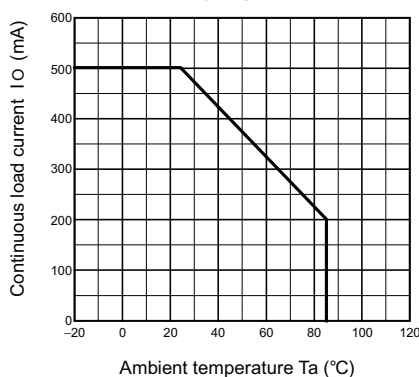
LED forward current vs. Ambient temperature

$I_F - T_a$



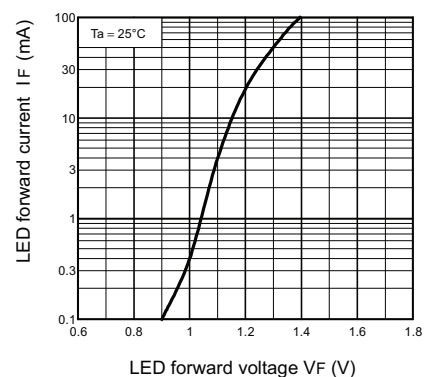
Continuous load current vs. Ambient temperature

$I_O - T_a$



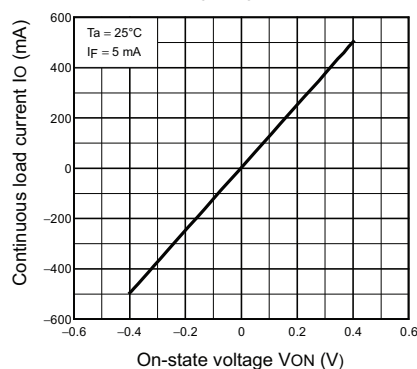
LED forward current vs. LED forward voltage

$I_F - V_F$



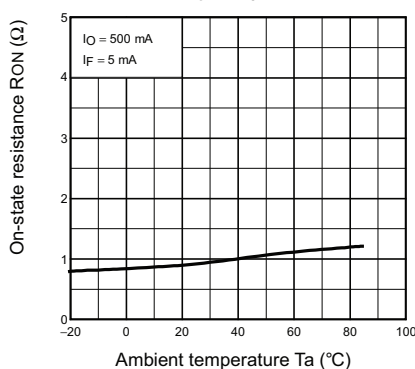
Continuous load current vs. On-state voltage

$I_O - V_{ON}$



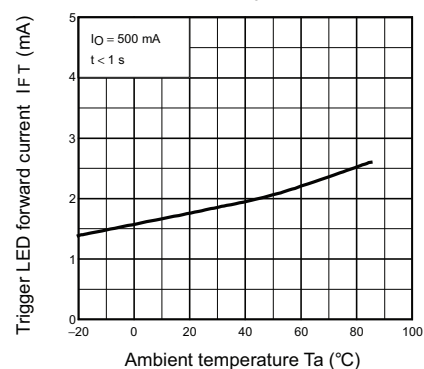
On-state resistance vs. Ambient temperature

$R_{ON} - T_a$



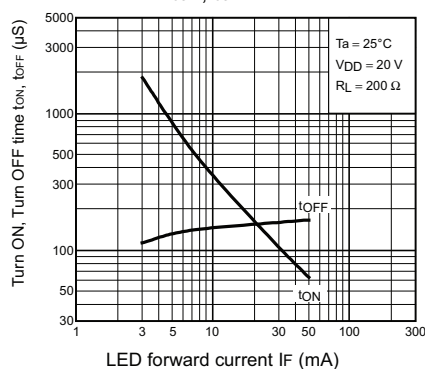
Trigger LED forward current vs. Ambient temperature

$I_{FT} - T_a$



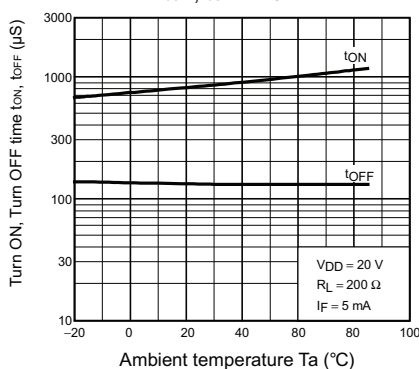
Turn ON, Turn OFF time vs. LED forward current

$t_{ON}, t_{OFF} - I_F$



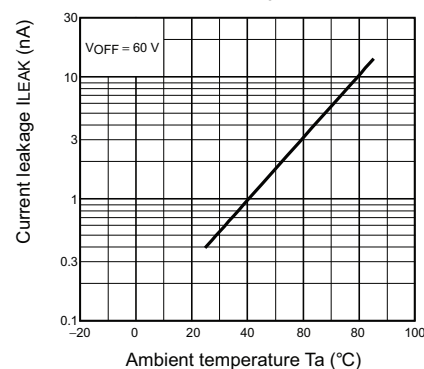
Turn ON, Turn OFF time vs. Ambient temperature
