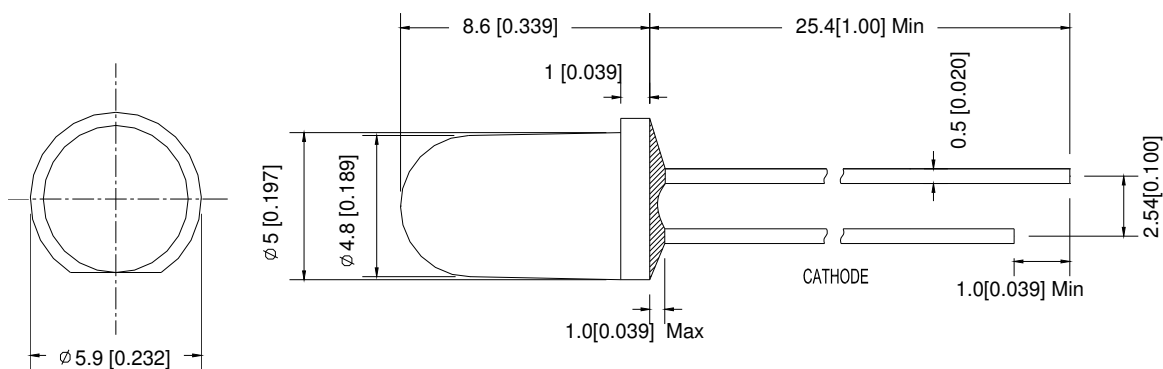

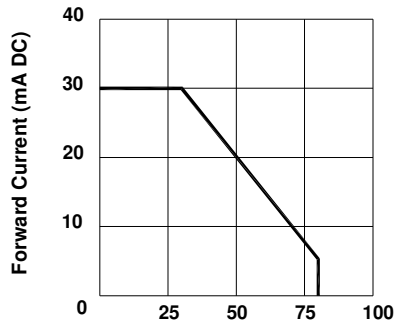

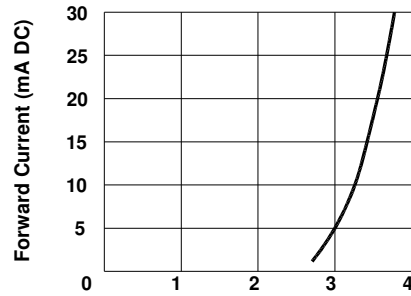

■ Typical Electrical / Optical Characteristics Curves -

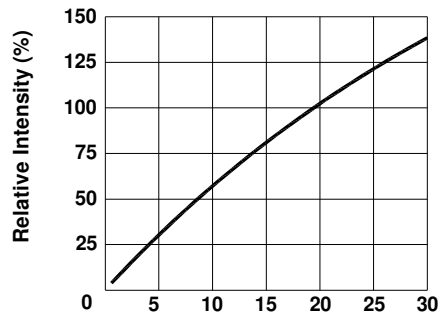

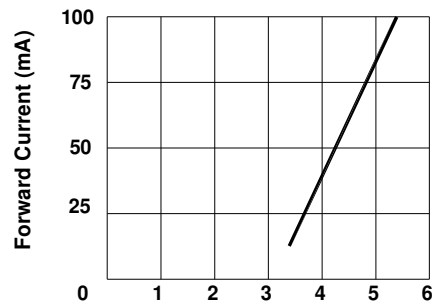
Ambient Temperature Ta (°C)

(100us test pulse, 1% duty cycle)

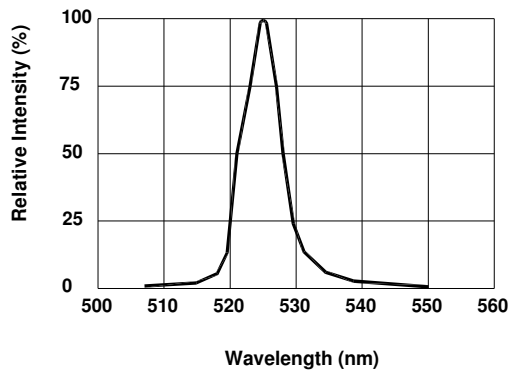


Fig 5. Relative Intensity Vs. Wavelength

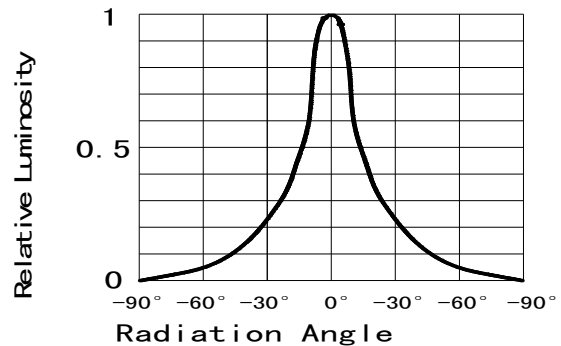


Fig 6. Relative Luminous Intensity vs. Radiation Angle

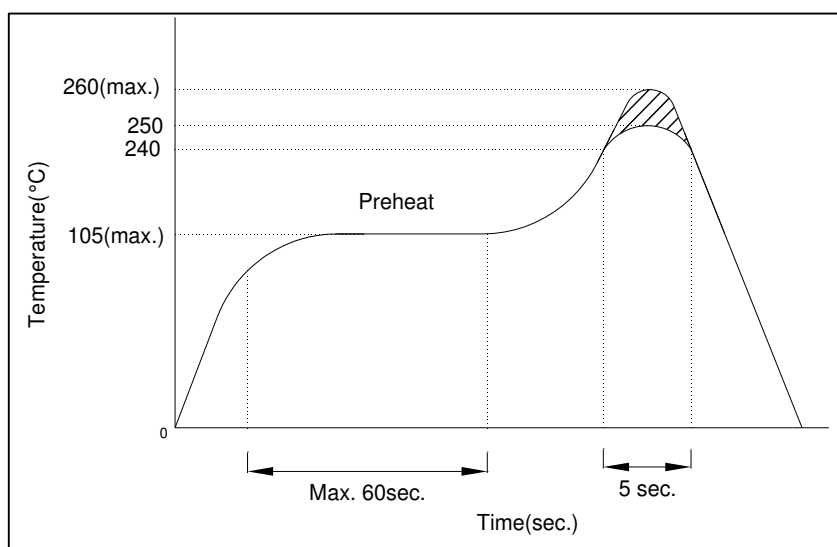

■ **Precautions For Use -**

1. Recommended Soldering conditions

Wave Soldering



2. Soldering Iron

Basic SPEC. is $\leq 5\text{sec.}$ When 260°C . If temperature is higher, time should be shorter ($+10^{\circ}\text{C} \rightarrow -1\text{sec.}$). Power dissipation of iron should be smaller than 15W, and temperature should be controllable. Surface temperature of the device should be under 230°C .

3. Static Electricity

- Static electricity or surge voltage damages LEDs..
It is recommended that a wrist band or an anti-electrostatic glove be used when handling the LEDs.
- All devices, equipment and machinery must be properly grounded. It is recommended that measures be taken against surge voltage to the equipment that mounts the LEDs.
